



NOTICE
APPROVAL AND REPEAL OF REGULATIONS

By the authority conferred by Article IV, Item c and j of the Reorganization Plan No. 4 of June 22, 1994, the Secretary of the Department of Economic Development and Commerce will have the faculty to approve, formulate, adopt, amend norms and regulations to establish the strategies for the economic development of Puerto Rico. In accordance with Section 19 of Act No. 73 of May 28, 2008 also known as Economic Incentives for the Development of Puerto Rico Act, the Secretary will authorize the necessary regulations to make effective the dispositions and objectives of the law. Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 170 of August 12, 1988, as amended, also known as the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, we herein notify to the general public the intention to adopt the following regulations:

- Regulation about the Collection Fee Filing Findings to fulfill the obligation of the Section 13(a) (1) of the Act. No. 73.
- Regulation to Establish Parameters of Interagency Cooperation Rules with the purpose to fulfill with cooperation process for interagency information exchanges and their municipalities related with the business exempt under the Act No. 73, Act 135, and previous incentives laws.
- Regulation about the Report Filing to Establish Rules and Norms in accordance with the Section 18, 3(a)(3)(c) of the Act No. 73.
- Administrative Order to Establish the Classification of the Industrial Development Zones of Puerto Rico in accordance with the Act. No. 73.

The proposed approval and repeal of Regulations will be available for comments to the general public through the web page and in the Office of Tax and Legislative Affairs of the Puerto Rico Industrial Development Company.
