
AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT OF THE PROPOSED REGULATIONS AND RELATED DOCUMENTS:

The Public Service Commission of Puerto Rico will acknowledge receipt of the comments in writing within two (2) working days, in accordance to Section 2.1 of Law 170, *supra*. Requests to file oral statements to the proposed rules during the hearing must be in writing, and shall be received within the same period of 30 days, from the publication date of this notice.
