INTENTION TO MODIFY THE  
PUERTO RICO AIR MONITORING NETWORK PLAN 2015

The Puerto Rico Environmental Quality Board (PREQB) accordance with Parts 53 and 58 in Title 40 of the Code 40 of Federal Regulations (CER) has prepared the **Puerto Rico Air Monitoring Network Plan 2015**. This plan must be submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency for its approval.

The State and Local Air Monitoring Network Plan provides information about ambient air quality monitoring sites in Puerto Rico. The network measures the ambient levels of criteria pollutants or those pollutants on which National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) have been established. The plan proposes some changes to the actual network according with the new requirements.

The Puerto Rico Air Monitoring Network Plan 2015 will be available for public revision in the Environmental Quality Board website, [www.jca.gobierno.pr](http://www.jca.gobierno.pr), and from Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 and 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. during 30 days at the Environmental Quality Board Library, located at the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of the Environmental Building Cruz A. Matos, Urb. San José Industrial Park, 1375 Ave. Ponce de León, San Juan, PR 00926-2604.
