**AMENDMENTS TO REGULATIONS ON
DRUG TESTING DETECTION**

The Office of the Women's Advocate pursuant to its delegated regulatory authority under, Act No. 20, of April 11, 2001 also known as Office of the Women's Advocate and under the provisions of Act No. 78, of August 14, 1997, as amended, also known as *Drug Testing Detection in the Public Service*, announces its proposal to amend *Regulations on Drug Testing at the Office of the Women's Advocate*.

The amendments to *Regulations on Drug Testing Detection* shall change its title and redefine the term "sensitive position of the Office of the Women's Advocate".

The *Regulations on Drug Testing Detection at the Office of the Women's Advocate* will be effective thirty (30) days after the filing date at the State Department of Puerto Rico.
