



PUBLIC NOTICE

The Department of the Family of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico intends to adopt a new regulation to be known as “Regulation for the fixation of administrative fines and collection of licenses”, which apply to centers of care, learning and development for children; facilities for the elderly; and adoption agencies. This Regulation will establish the uniform requirements for the fixation of administrative fines and the costs for license applications, among other aspects, under the provisions of Law 173 of August 12, 2016 and Law 94 of June 22, 1997, as amended.

In compliance with Section 2.1 of Law Number 170 of August 12, 1988, Uniform Administrative Procedure Law of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, a copy of the proposed rule will be available for revision during business hours from Monday to Friday from 8:00 a. m. to 4:30 p. m. in the Systems and Procedures Office of the Department of the Family at 306 Barbosa Avenue, Lila Mayoral Building, Hato Rey, Puerto Rico.
