Notice of Funding Announcement (NOFA) of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Continuum of Care Competitive Program for fiscal year 2015 of the

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) announced the 2015 competition for the Continuum of Care (CoC) Program funds. The municipalities included in the CoC PR-502 are the following: Aibonito, Arecibo, Barceloneta, Barranquitas, Bayamón, Camuy, Carolina, Cataño, Ciales, Comerío, Corozal, Dorado, Florida, Guaynabo, Lares, Morovis, Naranjito, Orocovis, San Juan, Toa Alta, Toa Baja, Utuado, Vega Alta and Vega Baja.

The CoC PR- 502 will use the policies and procedures established for the prioritization and selection of projects to be included for consideration by HUD.

In addition, interested parties may review the information in the NOFA at the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Information Technology, Puerto Rico Department of the Family, located at 306 Barbosa Avenue, Hato Rey, Puerto Rico, Lila Mayoral Building, 5th Floor, from September 20, 2015, during working hours.

Entities or municipalities interested in applying for these funds must submit a letter of intent to the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Information Technology of the Department of the Family on or before September 30, 2015.
