

Governor — Capital Improvement Projects; Reports to the Legislature

Act No. 153 of June 28, 1968

To provide that the Governor of the Commonwealth submit reports to the Legislature on projects for permanent improvements to be carried out by the different agencies of the Executive Branch, with appropriations made from the General Fund, the construction of which has not been started one year after the appropriation of funds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Puerto Rico:

Section 1. — [Capital improvement projects; reports to the Legislature] (3 L.P.R.A. § 17)

It shall be the duty of the Governor to submit a report to the Legislature, at the opening of each regular session on capital improvement projects chargeable to the General Fund to be carried out by the different agencies of the Executive Branch, the construction of which has not been started, excluding those authorized at the immediately preceding Legislative Session. This report shall contain the reasons which have prevented the start of the work.

Section 2. — This act shall take effect July 1, 1968

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
