



The Manufacture, Import or Distribution of Commercial Fertilizer, soil amendment, organic fertilizer, will not be allowed unless its grade and formulation has been evaluated by the “**Junta de Abonos**” (board of fertilizer), and approved by the Secretary for each trademark of each product.

REQUIREMENTS TO DISTRIBUTE AND SELL FERTILIZER IN PUERTO RICO

The person or the company must submit a written petition to the following address:

Your petition must include the following information:

1. Name and address of the applicant
2. Name and address of the manufacturer, if not same as applicant
3. Grade, weight in pounds, formulation, and raw materials used in the manufacturing of the product, source of nutrient.
4. Trademark to be adopted
5. Purpose or use of product
6. One original label and seven (7) facsimiles of the final label to be used
7. A person who represent the company in Puerto Rico
8. Submit a certification remitted by the DAUSA or the DA of any other state the USA or country from which the fertilizer precedes, to give proof that the state or place of origin is pest free established in the Administrative Order #2002-019” (see Attachment 1), for a list of pests. If the fertilizer proceeds from a location where pests established in the Administrative Order #2002-019, it must comply with the additional requirements established on annexed 2.
9. Materials Safety Data Sheets, if available.

Once the petition is received it shall be examined and evaluated by the Board of Fertilizer for pertinent recommendation to the Secretary, who determines the final approval of the product.

Other requirements should be submitted after the approvals:

1. If the registered can't submitted the required in Section 10, must compliance with the Article IV-B (7) of the Regulation (attachment 2A)
2. \$10.00 per products to be registered
3. Bond (Annual)
4. Taxes (20¢ each ton.)
